Our vicar is Fr. John H. Taylor, who came to St. John's in October 2004. Born in Detroit, Fr. John has also worked as a newspaper reporter, an aide to former President Richard Nixon, and executive director of the Richard Nixon Library & Birthplace Foundation in Yorba Linda.

He was ordained as a priest in January 2004 after studying at Bloy House at the Claremont School of Theology. Bishop Bruno named him an honorary canon of the Diocese of Los Angeles in 2008.
